

Protective socks

Description

The CBRN protective socks have been developed by Paul Boyé to provide optimal comfort and maximum protection for the wearer. **They are made of a filtering complex similar to the one used for CBRN protective suits.** CBRN socks are worn with combat boots allowing the wearer to maintain an excellent mobility.

The assembling technology used provide the best comfort possible while reducing fabric overlapping and thus avoiding any foot injury due to friction.

Performance

- Up to 24 hours protection against vapour CWA
- Shall be used in conjunction with boots to ensure protection against liquids.
- Washable up to 4 times
- 30 days continuous use
